


# Digging Deeper

## Read Acts 2:1-21

How many days have passed since Jesus' ascension into heaven?  
Where are the disciples at in our lesson this week? (see Luke 24:49; Acts 1:4)

What signs accompanied the arrival of the Holy Spirit? What do you think the significance of that was?

What were the disciples able to do after they were filled with the Holy Spirit?

What reactions did the crowd have to what they were experiencing?

How does Peter begin his sermon? Does anything strike you about that? (see Luke 24:45)

What does the last verse of this section tell us about the purpose for all the miracles on Pentecost?

# Connecting

What lesson is there for us in the list of nations we find in verses 9-11 and the kinds of people we find listed in verses 17-18?

When we feel nervous or afraid to share the truth of the gospel with others how can the events of Pentecost reassure us and fill us with confidence?

Are there obstacles preventing you from sharing the gospel truth? What might you do to eliminate those obstacles?
